08/41. APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE.

Apologies were received from Cllrs Daniels, Desmond and Galione.

08/42. MINUTES OF THE LAST MEETING.

The minutes of 27 May 2008 were approved as a correct record of events.

08/43. PROGRESS CHECK.

08/39. Station Road – the entrance to the field has been made for combine use.

08/46. PLANNING.

Application No: 08/00932/FUL. Erection of a new three bedroom dwelling.

Location: Land adjacent 20 Vicarage Avenue, White Notley.

Having studied the plans and looked at the site, councillors agreed to oppose this application for the following reasons:

- The plans state that the 'existing single storey extension' is to be removed. This is in fact part of the original building and not an extension, by removing it, it will break up the symmetrical design of the two houses and therefore not be in keeping with its surroundings.
- Parking/access issues there are discrepancies with the proposed parking on the plans and an issue with access to both nos: 18 and 20 – the dropped kerb is in a turning area and apparently cannot be extended.
- The plans also state that there are no hedgerows or trees on the site this isn't the case there are trees and hedgerows.

The overall accuracy of the plans was questioned and the Council agreed that over development of a small village has a significant affect on the quality of life issues for its residents.
