MINUTES OF THE COUNCIL MEETING HELD ON TUESDAY 23 AUGUST 2011 AT WHITE NOTLEY VILLAGE HALL AT 7.30 PM.

11/14. APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE.

Apologies were received from Cllrs Hardy, McKoy and Wagstaff.

11/15. MINUTES OF THE LAST MEETING.

11/16. PROGRESS CHECK.

11/20. COMMUNITY SPEED WATCH AND SPEED INDICATOR DEVICE (SID).

Speed checks have been done in Faulkbourne and data from the device currently situated in Station Road still shows a high level vehicles going above the limit. A solar panel to recharge the SID battery was considered but dismissed, as advice from the manufacturer says that the panel works better on a fixed permanent device. With regard to having the device calibrated, the manufacturer has advised that the device is accurate and does not need calibrating.
