16/57. APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE.

Apologies were received from Cllrs Daniels and J Harrison.

16/58. MINUTES OF THE LAST MEETING.

16/59. PROGRESS CHECK.

County Council – Cllr Abbott informed the meeting that ECC hedges will now only be cut once a year in September and that the Local Highways Panel budget has been halved.

The current White Notley & Faulkbourne bus services are up for renewal with various options – Cllr Bright completed the consultation document on behalf of the Council and it was suggested that services are not withdrawn but it may be acceptable to have smaller buses.

16/64. FAULKBOURNE SPEED MANAGEMENT.

Due to the cut in the budget for the Local Highways Panel it is unlikely that any proposal for speed cameras will be taken forward.

16/65. INDEPENDENT REPORT TO INVESTIGATE THE CAUSE OF POSSIBLE FLOODING ISSUES.

Anglian Water have been out and examined the area and say it is a storm problem. Highways are due to look at the area and should report back within 28 days. Next agenda
